



RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 21-1, Omaha Municipal Code, the Director of the Parks, Recreation and Public Property Department established rules regulating the use of parks within the city which were then approved by Resolution of the City Council; and,

WHEREAS, one such rule established the hours during which Memorial Park would be closed (from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.), which rule was approved by the City Council by Resolution on September 30, 1997; and,

WHEREAS, the *Bank of the West Celebrates America Concert* event will be held at Memorial Park, 6005 Underwood Avenue, on Friday, June 28, 2013; and,

WHEREAS, it has been requested that the park closing hours be suspended between the hours of 11:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 26, 2013 and 5:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 29, 2013, to accommodate the set-up and tear down of equipment and overnight security for this event; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of the Parks, Recreation and Public Property Department has approved the suspension of the park closing hours on those days only for this event; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended approval of this request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

THAT, as recommended by the Mayor, between 11:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 26, 2013 and 5:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 29, 2013, Memorial Park, 6005 Underwood Avenue, shall be open to accommodate set-up and tear down of equipment and overnight security for the *Bank of the West Celebrates America Concert* event.
