The Mobile Radio Base Stations and Repeaters will be used by the Sarpy County Emergency Management Agency and the Regional Incident Dispatch Team (IDT), that will enable local and regional Incident Dispatch Team (IDT) Members to interoperate throughout the Tri-County UASI (Urban Area Security Initiative), enhancing cross-jurisdictional communication and coordination and ensure the ability to interface and operate within the bounds of State of Nebraska Mutual Aid Frequency Overlay Plan.

Motorola, Inc. is the sole vendor for the Mobile Radio Base Stations and Repeaters, which will interface and enable an interoperable mobile communications system component throughout the Tri-County Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI), enhancing cross-jurisdictional communication and coordination. In accordance with the provisions of Section 5.16, Home Rule Charter, in the event of a sole source vendor, the City Council may, by resolution, authorize the Purchasing Division to issue a purchase order for the services.

The Mobile Radio Base Stations and Receivers are budgeted and will be funded by the Nebraska Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) FY 2008 State Homeland Security Grant Program, Award # 2008-GE-T8-0054, approved by City Council on April 28, 2009, Ordinance No. 38406, Fund 12151, Organization 130762.

RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

WHEREAS, Motorola, Inc. submitted a quote in the amount of sixty-four-thousand three-hundred sixteen dollars and ten cents (\$64,316.10) for Mobile Radio Base Stations and Repeaters to be used by the Sarpy County Emergency Management Agency and the Regional Incident Dispatch Team (IDT); and,

WHEREAS, Motorola, Inc. is the sole source vendor for this product as provided in Chapter 5.16 of the Home Rule Charter; and,

WHEREAS, the Mobile Radio Base Stations and Repeaters will enable local and regional Incident Dispatch Team (IDT) Members to interoperate throughout the Tri-County UASI (Urban Area Security Initiative), enhancing cross-jurisdictional communication and coordination; and,

WHEREAS, The purchase is budgeted from and will be funded by the Nebraska Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) FY 2008 State Homeland Security Grant Program, Award # 2008-GE-T8-0054; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends your favorable consideration of this Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAHA:

THAT, as recommended by the Mayor, this City Council does hereby approve the purchase from Motorola, Inc., a sole source vendor provided in Chapter 5.16 of the Home Rule Charter in the amount of sixty-four-thousand three-hundred sixteen dollars and ten cents (\$64,316.10) for Mobile Radio Base Stations and Repeaters, for the Sarpy County Emergency Management Agency and the Regional Incident Dispatch Team (IDT), which will enable local and regional Incident Dispatch Team (IDT) Members to interoperate throughout the Tri-County UASI (Urban Area Security Initiative), enhancing cross-jurisdictional communication and coordination which will enhance the ability to interface and operate within the State of Nebraska Mutual Aid Frequency overlay plan, is hereby approved.

FURTHER THAT, the Finance Department of the City of Omaha is authorized to pay Motorola, Inc. in the amount of \$64,316.10 for Mobile Radio Base Stations and Repeaters, budgeted from and funded by the Nebraska Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) FY 2008 State Homeland Security Grant Program, Award # 2008-GE-T8-0054, Fund 12151, Organization 130762.

**Justification for Non-Competitive Procurement;  
2008 State Homeland Security Grant**

12-16-2010

Sarpy County, NE. as a member of the Omaha UASI / Tri County PET Region, is in the process of procuring equipment necessary to build out a “regional mobile communications system” that would support a STR (Strategic Technological Reserve) project much in the line with other grant funded equipment in the region and state.

The Sarpy County communications backbone is a trunked 800 MHz radio system as is Douglas and Washington Counties. In order for the STR mobile communications system to be standardized across the region, will need to interface with and serve in capacity much like the existing Motorola equipment. The proposed equipment can and will be installed by our own Communication Technicians as well as the maintenance and support for the STR here locally and in the field. Sarpy County Communication Technicians can provide for the initial testing and programming of equipment and continue to update and maintain standardized Motorola equipment thus saving maintenance and programming costs that would not be realized if not for a sole source non-competitive purchase approval.

Motorola, Inc. is the sole vendor for regional communication systems and thus provides support to those existing systems and local Technicians within the Tri County Region Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI). The proposed purchase of said equipment, Mobile Radio Base Stations and Repeaters, will interface and enable an interoperable mobile communications system component throughout the Tri-County Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI), enhancing cross-jurisdictional communication and coordination.

The purchase of the standardized equipment will provide for that initial start up of a Regional “Strategic Technological Reserve” that could be deployed to help manage interoperable communications on an event by event basis giving the IDT (Incident Dispatch Team) members flexible field resources within the region for a mobile deployable communication system for not only the field responses but in support of an a forced evacuation of a PSAP (Public Safety Answering Point).

Sarpy, Washington and Douglas County Public Safety personnel will have access to the STR as a regional asset to provide mobile communications where an event has the propensity to cross into another jurisdiction creating interoperability.

The communication equipment purchase of these items is in the best interest of both Sarpy County and the Tri County Region based on cost, functionality and standardization to ensure a cohesive and common operational platform for Public Safety Communications.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 5.16, Home Rule Charter, in the event of a sole source vendor, the City Council may, by resolution, authorize the Purchasing Division to issue a purchase order for the proposed equipment.
